IAA Year End Awards Program Rules:

Horses & Exhibitors **MUST BE NOMINATED** to participate by completion of the attached nomination form. Nomination forms must be postmarked prior to a show for the points to count. In the event a horse is nominated at a show, the form **MUST** be received by a Director **PRIOR** to entering the show ring for the points to count: **NOTE:** If all information is not available prior to entering the show ring, submit the nomination form and follow it up afterwards with the missing information. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

IAA Show Rules are listed below:

1. All paid members of the Iowa Appaloosa Association are eligible to earn year-end awards provided they show under 50% the judges hired by the Iowa Appaloosa Association.
2. All paid members are now required to nominate their horse for year end awards on the IAA Year End High Point Awards Entry Form. There will be a \$10 charge per horse entered.

Requirements for eligibility for Year End Awards:

- Be an IAA Member (rule 1)
- Show under 50% of the judges hired by the IAA .
- Fill out IAA Year End High Point Awards Entry Form (rule 2)
- Pay \$10 fee per horse entered (rule 2)
- Double pointed judges count as two judges

3. Points from the Iowa Appaloosa Association sponsored shows plus all shows cross-pointed with other clubs will be counted for year-end awards.

4. Year-end High Point winners will be nominated to represent the Iowa Appaloosa Association at the World Championship Appaloosa Show as recorded in the club's point system.

5. The Iowa Appaloosa Association points will be assigned as follows:

A. Exhibitors placing in the top six (6) in any class will be awarded one (1) point for themselves and one (1) point for each entry placing below them, not to exceed six (6) points for first place. In classes of six (6) or fewer entries a DQ or NT will receive one (1) club point. If prepared to show, and the only one in a class, a scratch at the gate will still receive one (1) club point.

Example: 20 entries - 1st = 6 pts, 2nd = 5 pts, 3rd = 4 pts, 4th = 3 pts, 5th = 2 pts, 6th = 1 pt.

Example: 4 entries - 1st = 4 pts, 2nd = 3 pts, 3rd = 2 pts, 4th = 1 pt.

B. Grand Champions will receive two (2) points more than the winner of the largest class in their sex division. Reserve Champions will receive one (1) point more than the winner of the largest class in their sex division.

6. Ties will be broken by first comparing the number of first places, then the number of second places and so on through six places. If a tie still exists a comparison of the number of times shown at Iowa Appaloosa Association sponsored shows will be made. Should a tie still exist there will be a coin toss to determine the high point.
